

## SMALL

1. Chain thirty-four stitches in the foundation chain. (34 stitches)
2. Yarn over and insert into the third stitch from the hook. Yarn over again and pull through the first two loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull through the remaining two loops. \*Yarn over and insert into the next stitch. Yarn over again and pull through the first two loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull through the remaining two loops\*. Repeat from \* to \* (HHDC) for the rest of the row. (33 stitches – the two skipped stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
3. Chain two stitches. HHDC into each stitch, starting in the third stitch closest to the hook. Do an additional HHDC in the last stitch of the row. (35 stitches)
4. Repeat step 3 ten more times. (37 / 39 / 41 / 43 / 45 / 47 / 49 / 51 / 53 / 55 stitches)
5. Chain two stitches. HHDC into each stitch, starting from the fourth stitch from the hook. (55 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
6. Repeat step 5 eighteen more times. (55 stitches)
7. Turn your work so that you are working along the side of the crop top and SC twenty-two times. The SC should finish at the very first row of fifty-five HHDC. (22 stitches)
8. Chain two stitches and HDC in the front loop of each stitch, starting from the fourth stitch from the hook. (22 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
9. Repeat step 8 eleven more times. (22 stitches)
10. Chain two stitches. **HDC decrease** in the front loop over the next two stitches, starting from the fourth stitch from the hook. HDC decrease in the front loop over the next two stitches. HDC in the front loop each stitch for the rest of the row. (20 stitches – the two chain stitches from the beginning also count as a stitch)
11. Chain two stitches and HDC in the front loop of each stitch, starting from the second stitch in the row. (20 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
12. Repeat steps 10 and 11 six more times. Cast off, leaving a long tail for weaving in. Attach a button to this strap! (18 / 16 / 14 / 12 / 10 / 8 stitches)
13. Repeat steps 7 to 12 on the other side of the crop top, with one change! When starting the row that will have ten stitches, do the two HDC decrease stitches, then chain two

stitches while skipping two stitches, then finish the row with four normal HDC stitches. This will create a buttonhole!

14. Turn your work so that you are working along the bottom of the crop top, and SC one hundred and thirty-one times. The SC should finish at the end of the strap with the button. (131 stitches)
15. SC into the second stitch from the hook. \*Chain five stitches while skipping three stitches, then SC into the next stitch\*. Repeat from \* to \* until the last two stitches. Chain two stitches while skipping one stitch, then DC into the last stitch.
16. Chain one. SC into the first stitch from the hook, then skip two stitches. \*DC into the next stitch. DC increase. DC. DC increase. DC. Skip three stitches and SC.\*\* Chain five while skipping five stitches. SC. Skip three stitches.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the last two stitches, with the last repetition ending at \*\*. Chain two stitches while skipping one stitch, then TC into the last stitch.
17. Chain one. SC into the first stitch from the hook. \*Chain five while skipping four stitches. SC. Chain five while skipping three stitches. SC.\*\* Chain five while skipping four stitches. SC.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the last two stitches, with the last repetition ending at \*\*. Chain two stitches while skipping one stitch, then TC into the last stitch.
18. Repeat steps 16 and 17 four more times. Cast off, leaving a long tail for weaving in.

## MEDIUM

1. Chain thirty-seven stitches in the foundation chain. (37 stitches)
2. Yarn over and insert into the third stitch from the hook. Yarn over again and pull through the first two loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull through the remaining two loops. \*Yarn over and insert into the next stitch. Yarn over again and pull through the first two loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull through the remaining two loops\*. Repeat from \* to \* (HHDC) for the rest of the row. (36 stitches – the two skipped stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
3. Chain two stitches. HHDC into each stitch, starting from the stitch closest to the hook. Do an additional HHDC in the last stitch of the row. (38 stitches)
4. Repeat step 3 ten more times. (40 / 42 / 44 / 46 / 48 / 50 / 52 / 54 / 56 / 58 stitches)
5. Chain two stitches. HHDC into each stitch, starting from the third stitch from the hook. (58 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
6. Repeat step 5 eighteen more times. (58 stitches)
7. Turn your work so that you are working along the side of the crop top and SC twenty-two times. The SC should finish at the very first row of fifty-eight HHDC. (22 stitches)
8. Chain two stitches and HDC in the front loop of each stitch, starting in the fourth stitch from the hook. (22 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
9. Repeat step 8 twelve more times. (22 stitches)
10. Chain two stitches. **HDC decrease** in the front loop over the next two stitches, starting from the third stitch from the hook. HDC decrease in the front loop over the next two stitches. HDC in the front loop each stitch for the rest of the row. (20 stitches – the two chain stitches from the beginning also count as a stitch)
11. Chain two stitches and HDC in the front loop of each stitch, starting from the third stitch from the hook. (20 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
12. Repeat steps 10 and 11 six more times. Cast off, leaving a long tail for weaving in. Attach a button to this strap! (18 / 16 / 14 / 12 / 10 / 8 stitches)
13. Repeat steps 7 to 12 on the other side of the crop top, with one change! When starting the row that will have ten stitches, do the two HDC decrease stitches, then chain two

stitches while skipping two stitches, then finish the row with four normal HDC stitches. This will create a buttonhole!

14. Turn your work so that you are working along the bottom of the crop top, and SC one hundred and forty-three times. The SC should finish at the end of the strap with the button. (143 stitches)
15. SC into the second stitch from the hook. \*Chain five stitches while skipping three stitches, then SC into the next stitch\*. Repeat from \* to \* until the last two stitches. Chain two stitches while skipping one stitch, then DC into the last stitch.
16. Chain one. SC into the first stitch from the hook, then skip two stitches. \*DC into the next stitch. DC increase. DC. DC increase. DC. Skip three stitches and SC.\*\* Chain five while skipping five stitches. SC. Skip three stitches.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the last two stitches, with the last repetition ending at \*\*. Chain two stitches while skipping one stitch, then TC into the last stitch.
17. Chain one. SC into the first stitch from the hook. \*Chain five while skipping four stitches. SC. Chain five while skipping three stitches. SC.\*\* Chain five while skipping four stitches. SC.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the last two stitches, with the last repetition ending at \*\*. Chain two stitches while skipping one stitch, then TC into the last stitch.
18. Repeat steps 16 and 17 four more times. Cast off, leaving a long tail for weaving in.

## LARGE

1. Chain forty stitches in the foundation chain. (40 stitches)
2. Yarn over and insert into the third stitch from the hook. Yarn over again and pull through the first two loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull through the remaining two loops. \*Yarn over and insert into the next stitch. Yarn over again and pull through the first two loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull through the remaining two loops\*. Repeat from \* to \* (HHDC) for the rest of the row. (39 stitches – the two skipped stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
3. Chain two stitches. HHDC into each stitch, starting in the third stitch from the hook. Do an additional HHDC in the last stitch of the row. (41 stitches)
4. Repeat step 3 eleven more times. (43 / 45 / 47 / 49 / 51 / 53 / 55 / 57 / 59 / 61 / 63 stitches)
5. Chain two stitches. HHDC into each stitch, starting from the fourth stitch from the hook. (63 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
6. Repeat step 5 twenty more times. (63 stitches)
7. Turn your work so that you are working along the side of the crop top and SC twenty-four times. The SC should finish at the very first row of sixty-three HHDC. (24 stitches)
8. Chain two stitches and HDC in the front loop of each stitch, starting from the third stitch from the hook. (24 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
9. Repeat step 8 sixteen more times. (24 stitches)
10. Chain two stitches. **HDC decrease** in the front loop over the next two stitches, starting from the third stitch from the hook. HDC decrease in the front loop over the next two stitches. HDC in the front loop each stitch for the rest of the row. (22 stitches – the two chain stitches from the beginning also count as a stitch)
11. Chain two stitches and HDC in the front loop of each stitch, starting from the third stitch from the hook. (22 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
12. Repeat steps 10 and 11 seven more times. Cast off, leaving a long tail for weaving in. Attach a button to this strap! (20 / 18 / 16 / 14 / 12 / 10 / 8 stitches)

13. Repeat steps 7 to 12 on the other side of the crop top, with one change! When starting the row that will have ten stitches, do the two HDC decrease stitches, then chain two stitches while skipping two stitches, then finish the row with four normal HDC stitches. This will create a buttonhole!
14. Turn your work so that you are working along the bottom of the crop top, and SC one hundred and sixty-seven times. The SC should finish at the end of the strap with the button. (167 stitches)
15. SC into the second stitch from the hook. \*Chain five stitches while skipping three stitches, then SC into the next stitch\*. Repeat from \* to \* until the last two stitches. Chain two stitches while skipping one stitch, then DC into the last stitch.
16. Chain one. SC into the first stitch from the hook, then skip two stitches. \*DC into the next stitch. DC increase. DC. DC increase. DC. Skip three stitches and SC.\*\* Chain five while skipping five stitches. SC. Skip three stitches.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the last two stitches, with the last repetition ending at \*\*. Chain two stitches while skipping one stitch, then TC into the last stitch.
17. Chain one. SC into the first stitch from the hook. \*Chain five while skipping four stitches. SC. Chain five while skipping three stitches. SC.\*\* Chain five while skipping four stitches. SC.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the last two stitches, with the last repetition ending at \*\*. Chain two stitches while skipping one stitch, then TC into the last stitch.
18. Repeat steps 16 and 17 five more times. Cast off, leaving a long tail for weaving in.

## EXTRA-LARGE

1. Chain forty-three stitches in the foundation chain. (43 stitches)
2. Yarn over and insert into the third stitch from the hook. Yarn over again and pull through the first two loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull through the remaining two loops. \*Yarn over and insert into the next stitch. Yarn over again and pull through the first two loops on the hook. Yarn over and pull through the remaining two loops\*. Repeat from \* to \* (HHDC) for the rest of the row. (42 stitches – the two skipped stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
3. Chain two stitches. HHDC into each stitch, starting in the third stitch from the hook. Do an additional HHDC in the last stitch of the row. (44 stitches)
4. Repeat step 3 eleven more times. (46 / 48 / 50 / 52 / 54 / 56 / 58 / 60 / 62 / 64 / 66 stitches)
5. Chain two stitches. HHDC into each stitch, starting from the fourth stitch from the hook. (66 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
6. Repeat step 5 twenty more times. (66 stitches)
7. Turn your work so that you are working along the side of the crop top and SC twenty-four times. The SC should finish at the very first row of sixty-six HHDC. (24 stitches)
8. Chain two stitches and HDC in the front loop of each stitch, starting from the third stitch from the hook. (24 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
9. Repeat step 8 sixteen more times. (24 stitches)
10. Chain two stitches. **HDC decrease** in the front loop over the next two stitches, starting from the third stitch from the hook. HDC decrease in the front loop over the next two stitches. HDC in the front loop each stitch for the rest of the row. (22 stitches – the two chain stitches from the beginning also count as a stitch)
11. Chain two stitches and HDC in the front loop of each stitch, starting from the third stitch from the hook. (22 stitches – the two chain stitches at the beginning also count as a stitch)
12. Repeat steps 10 and 11 seven more times. Cast off, leaving a long tail for weaving in. Attach a button to this strap! (20 / 18 / 16 / 14 / 12 / 10 / 8 stitches)

13. Repeat steps 7 to 12 on the other side of the crop top, with one change! When starting the row that will have ten stitches, do the two HDC decrease stitches, then chain two stitches while skipping two stitches, then finish the row with four normal HDC stitches. This will create a buttonhole!
14. Turn your work so that you are working along the bottom of the crop top, and SC one hundred and seventy-nine times. The SC should finish at the end of the strap with the button. (179 stitches)
15. SC into the second stitch from the hook. \*Chain five stitches while skipping three stitches, then SC into the next stitch\*. Repeat from \* to \* until the last two stitches. Chain two stitches while skipping one stitch, then DC into the last stitch.
16. Chain one. SC into the first stitch from the hook, then skip two stitches. \*DC into the next stitch. DC increase. DC. DC increase. DC. Skip three stitches and SC.\*\* Chain five while skipping five stitches. SC. Skip three stitches.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the last two stitches, with the last repetition ending at \*\*. Chain two stitches while skipping one stitch, then TC into the last stitch.
17. Chain one. SC into the first stitch from the hook. \*Chain five while skipping four stitches. SC. Chain five while skipping three stitches. SC.\*\* Chain five while skipping four stitches.
